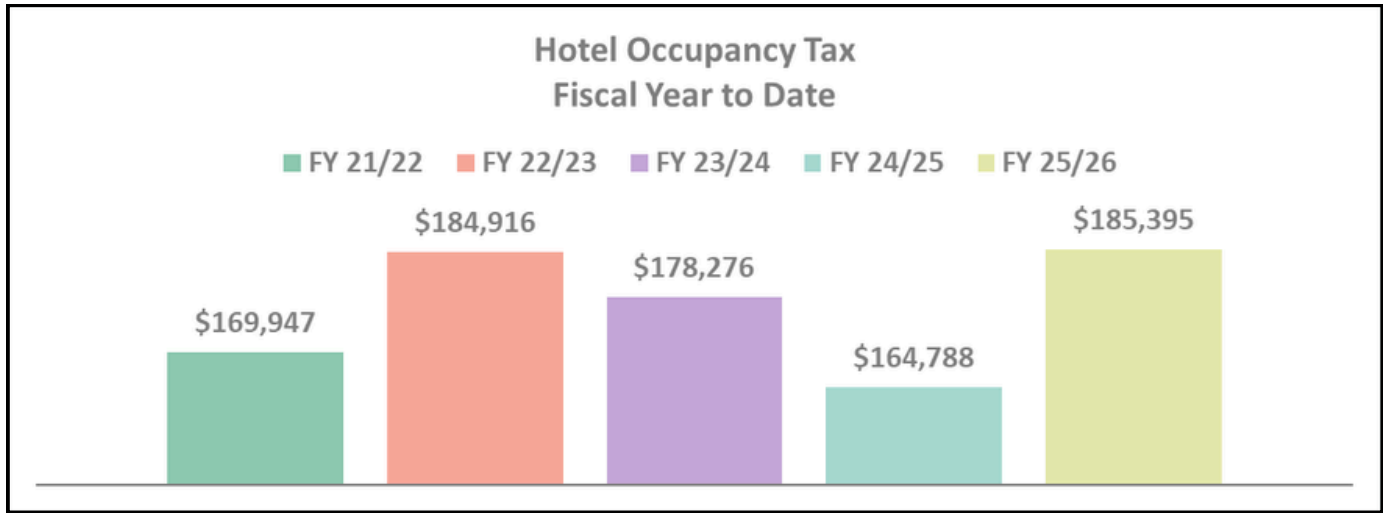
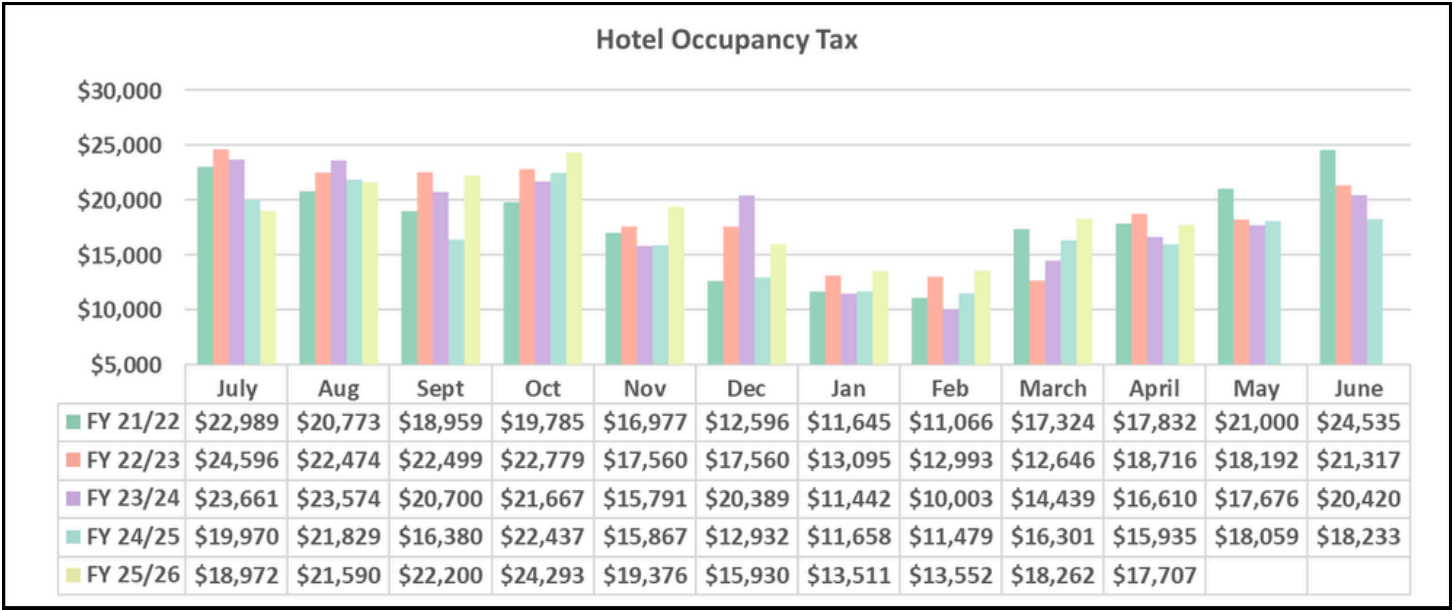
CITY OF CROSSVILLE WHOLESALE BEER TAX MAY 2026 REPORT



CITY OF CROSSVILLE LIQUOR TAX MAY 2026 REPORT

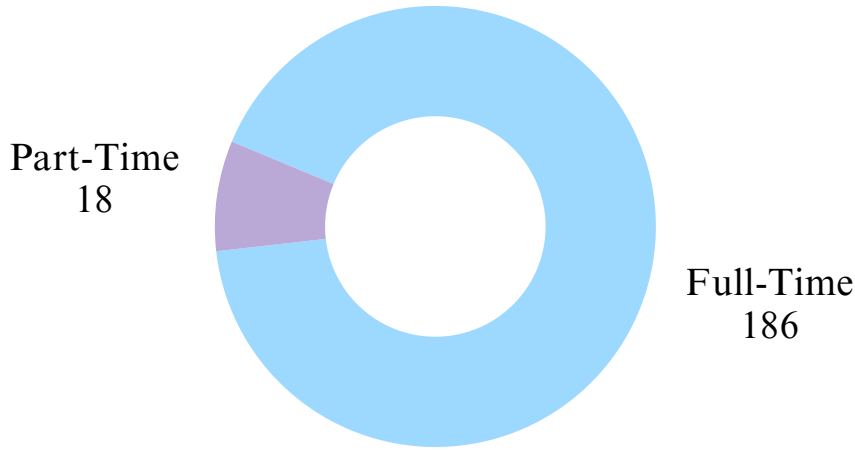
