

RE: Four Way Stop and Iris Circle and Deerfield Road

In the course of implementing plans to complete road construction connecting Iris Circle to Deerfield Road and Narcissus Street, it was discovered a four way stop at the intersection of Iris Circle and Deerfield Road is necessary. In the interest of public safety, this course of action is proposed due to the sight distance in this area is limited. Additionally, a four way stop would considerably reduce speeding along this roadway.

It is my recommendation to create a four way stop where Iris Circle intersects with Deerfield Road. Benefits of this installation are a public safety interest to the community and City employees working in this area.
