ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to add Title 12, Chapter 10 to the Crossville Municipal Code pertaining to mechanical codes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Title 12, Chapter 10 be added to the Crossville Municipal Code as follows:

12-1001. <u>International mechanical code adopted.</u> Pursuant to authority granted by *Tennessee Code Annotated*, §§6-54-501 through 6-54-506 and for the purpose of regulating and governing plumbing systems in the City of Crossville; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; the *International Mechanical Code*, 2012 edition, published by the International Code Council, including Appendix A, is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as a part of this code, and is hereinafter referred to as the mechanical code.

12-1002. <u>Modifications</u>. Whenever the mechanical code refers to the duties of certain officials named therein, the designated official who has duties corresponding to those of the named official in the code shall be deemed to be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of the mechanical code are concerned.

12-1003. <u>Available in clerk's office</u>. Pursuant to the requirements of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, §6-54-502, one (1) copy of the mechanical code has been placed on file in the clerk's office and shall be kept there for the use and inspection of the public.

12-1004. <u>Mechanical permits</u>. In addition to the various rules and regulations governing the issuance mechanical permits as outlined in the *International Mechanical Code* adopted herein, a separate mechanical permit shall be required to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any plumbing system.

12-1005. <u>Violations</u>. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with any provisions of the plumbing code as herein adopted by reference and modified.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall take effect upon and after its final date of passage, the public welfare requiring it.
