## City of Crossville - Brush Collection Schedule

The brush collection for the City of Crossville will be scheduled twice yearly per residential residence and picked up during the first 2 weeks of your scheduled month and is based on your trash pick up day. The schedule is as follows:

- If your trash pick up is on **Monday**, your brush pick up will be in February and June.
- If your trash pick up is on **Tuesday**, your brush pick up will be in March and July.
- If your trash pick up is on Wednesday, your brush pick up will be in April and August.
- If your trash pick up day is Thursday or Friday, your brush pick up will be in May and September.

## **Rules for Brush collection**

- 1. Brush from commercial tree and landscaping services must be disposed of by the company and not left for collection by the city contractor.
- 2. Limbs must not be larger than 3 inches in diameter and no longer than 4 feet.
- 3. Brush pile must be within 5 feet from the curb and not placed against trees, fences, utility poles or other stationary objects. Piles must be no larger than 4 foot high, 4 foot wide and 8 feet long.
- 4. Do not place brush at the curb more than 7 days prior to your scheduled pick up.
- 5. One brush pile per residence will be picked up per scheduled month.
- 6. Brush must be at the curb by the first Monday of your scheduled month. Crews will not make a return trip until your next scheduled month if your brush is not at the curb.
- 7. At other times of the year we will accept Bundles of brush on normal trash pickup days, but they must not weigh more than 35 pounds and be no more than 4 feet in length and 3 feet in diameter and must be securely tied as so to not come apart when loading into truck. With a maximum of 2 bundles per week.
