

MUTUAL AGREEMENT

The purpose of this document is to establish a mutual assistance agreement between the Cookeville Department of Water Quality Control (Water Department) and the Cookeville Fire Department. This agreement pertains to the response by the Crossville Fire Department to the Cookeville Water Treatment Plant located at 9722 Water Plant Road, Baxter, TN 38544 should there be a leak in the chlorine system, and/or a release of chlorine gas into the atmosphere, normally referred to as a "catastrophic release." This agreement shall be effective through June 30, 2014.

Material Safety Data Sheets will be furnished to the Crossville Fire Department by the Water Department and a copy of the same is to be maintained in a location at the Water Plant where Water Plant personnel may familiarize themselves, should such a problem arise, as stated above. In addition the Water Department shall keep on-site at the water treatment plant a chlorine emergency kit "B" for the use of the Crossville Fire Department to stop leaks on the one ton cylinders that are on hand at the water treatment plant.

If a leak is occurring or has occurred the Crossville Fire Department will respond to the Water Plant and work to stop the leak including using the emergency repair kit "B" furnished by the Water Department.
