

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to amend Sections 14-503, 504, and 507 to the Crossville Municipal Code pertaining to off-premises outdoor advertising signs.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and beneficial for the health, safety and welfare of the community to provide regulations to promote reasonable, orderly, and effective display of signs, to assure compatibility of signs, to enhance the economy of the City, to protect the visual quality of the environment for the public, to protect the motoring public, to enhance the beauty of the area, to promote tourism and to protect public investment in streets and highways.

WHEREAS, it is important to accommodate the growing need and demand for business signs and outdoor advertising while protecting the character of Crossville; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish standards for location, aesthetics and compatibility for business signs and outdoor advertising; and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Title 14, Chapters 503, 504, and 507 be replaced in its entirety to the Crossville Municipal Code as follows:

- (a) In order to ensure that the City and its compatibility and character are properly protected and an ordinance to cover all the issues is properly researched and drafted for presentation to Council, a temporary moratorium on the issuance of permits for off premise advertising in the City of Crossville is hereby enacted.
- (b) A committee is hereby appointed to draft and provide such recommended ordinance to City Council within six months of passage of this ordinance. The committee to consist of:
 - City Manager
 - City Clerk
 - GIS/Planning Administrator
 - Building Codes Official
 - City Attorney
 - Tom Flynn
 - Peter Nichols
 - Rodney Brown

SECTION II. This ordinance shall take effect upon and after its final date of passage, the public welfare requiring it.
