WHEREAS, the Cumberland Homesteads is one of the planned New Deal Communities built by the Division of Subsistence Homesteads between 1934 and 1938 and was the largest of the resettlement communities with approximately 200 homes still remaining; and

WHEREAS, it is important to share the nation's heritage by helping traveling citizens be aware and encouraged to visit the museum and historic district;
