My name is Cole Van Horn, and I'm the Operations Pastor for Cumberland Fellowship. We have decided this year we are going to do our Christmas Festival again. Last year was a successful first year, and it made the night so much smoother having part of the road closed off so the people coming from, what used to be, Kmart had easy access to our property.

In that regard, we had roughly 2,000 people who attended our Christmas Festival last year, and are expecting more this year since the parade and Friday at the Crossroads aren't on the same night. Due to limited parking on-site, we have partnered with Rural King Realty to use their Parking lot. Our primary concern at this point is safety. There is not a safe passage from, what used to be, Kmart to our campus. We feel the safest route for families to access our campus from Kmart would be to close off a lane of West Avenue for about 100 yards between the Old Kmart entrance and our Office entrance on West AVE. There is a turning lane in this location that could be utilized to maintain traffic flow. We feel taking this precaution will be the best option to keep families safe as they access our property.
