

Agreement for Retirement of Canine Arko

This agreement is made this 26, July 2019, between the Crossville Police Department, City of Crossville Tennessee and Dep. Chief Chris Kendrick. Dep. Chief Chris Kendrick has agreed to adopt and maintain Canine Arko which has been his partner for several years. Canine Arko has been trained to work with Dep. Chief Chris Kendrick and to partner with him only and is retiring due to age.


Dep. Chief Chris Kendrick understands and agrees that Canine Arko once retired is no longer eligible for work as a canine officer and that once retired, may not be activated or nor certified to work as any type of canine officer again, at any time in the future and may not be reactivated under any other department or police force, etc.

Dep. Chief Chris Kendrick agrees and understands that Canine Arko, once retired has no value to the Crossville Police Department or the City of Crossville. Canine Arko must remain cared for after retirement and kept healthy. The best means to accomplish this is to allow Canine Arko to be adopted by Dep. Chief Chris Kendrick and kept as his personal pet.
