#### Call to Order

**1.** Approval of 3/18 minutes

Release of Letters of Credit for Water & Sewer, Gardens Ph8 Plat 3

The developer has completed the installation of Water and Sewer for The Gardens Phase 8 Plat 3. Staff inspected and approved the lines and recommended the release of the Letters of Credit. The LOC for water is in the amount of \$62,000, and the LOC for sewer is in the amount of \$52,000.

A motion was made by Vice Chair Kevin Poore, seconded by Council Member Rob Harrison, to release the Letters of Credit. The motion carried by the following vote:

3. Revision of Lot 2 Edna Sherrill Sub

The property owner is proposing a simple subdivision with a variance request. Lot 1 has an existing septic system. They are requesting a variance for the requirement of a secondary system/soil testing for lot 1. They do have soil testing and State Environmentalist signature for lot 2. The existing system for lot 1 is a large existing system that was part of the old elementary school located in this area. Staff recommended approval of the plat with variance.

#### 4. Jesse Brown Subdivision

The property owner is proposing a 2 lot subdivision. This subdivision is located in the downtown area. The Planning Commission, in the past, has granted variances for setbacks. Without zoning, the city can't have different setbacks for different "areas." The owner is requesting 20 foot variance from West Ave, leaving a 30 foot setback. A 15 foot variance from Second Street, leaving a 15 foot setback, and a 30 foot variance for Division and Rector, leaving a zero foot setback. The requested setbacks are equal to those of buildings in the area. Staff doesn't see any safety issues by granting these variances. They are also requesting side and rear setbacks to be reduced to zero. Any new construction on these lots would be required to meet the current building code for zero lot line. Staff recommended approval of the plat with setback variances.
