ITEM #2 - Matters relative to Co-Linx

As discussed at the February 12 meeting, applications are being prepared for FastTrack Infrastructure funds and TDOT-State Industrial Access funds for Cox Ave. improvements. As expected, the Cumberland County Commission approved a resolution for them to file the application for FastTrack funds at their meeting on

February 19. A resolution was presented approving a proposal to provide the administrative services and the local match for the grant. Also requested for passage was a resolution authorizing the submittal of a TDOT-SIA grant application with the City providing the right-of-ways.

A motion was made by Council Member Pete Souza, seconded by Mayor J.H. Graham III, that the resolutions for FastTrack funding and an industrial access road for CoLinx be approved as recommended. The motion carried by the following vote: Aye: 5 - Council Member George Marlow, Mayor Pro-tem Danny Wyatt, Mayor J.H. Graham III, Council Member Pete Souza and Council Member Jesse Kerley.

ITEM #3 - Matters relative to soccer complex

As briefly discussed at the February 12th meeting, TDEC and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers initially determined that there may have been violations in the construction and site preparation of the soccer complex. Since that meeting, TDEC is reviewing the data and has asked for additional information. The City Manager employed Michael Stagg to provide legal counsel on this matter. Mr. Stagg was at the meeting to discuss the matter in closed executive session with the Council. (At 4:07 p.m., the special called meeting was recessed into closed executive session. At 4:45 p.m. the meeting was reconvened in open session.) City Manager Bruce Wyatt recommended that approval be given for the Mayor to sign the Letter of Engagement with Mr. Michael Stagg for legal counsel on this issue. City Attorney Kenneth Chadwell requested that the City Manager be given the authority to further authorize Mr. Stagg to further engage, under the attorney/client privilege, a soils expert to assist Mr. Stagg and report to him in furtherance of the work of Mr. Stagg on behalf of the city.

A motion was made by Council Member Pete Souza, seconded by Mayor J.H. Graham III, that the Letter of Engagement with Michael Stagg be approved as recommended and the City Manager be given the authority to further authorize Mr. Stagg to further engage, under the attorney/client privilege, a soils expert to assist Mr. Stagg and report to him in furtherance of the work of Mr. Stagg on behalf of the city. The motion carried by the following vote: Aye: 5 - Council Member George Marlow, Mayor Pro-tem Danny Wyatt, Mayor J.H. Graham III, Council Member Pete Souza and Council Member Jesse Kerley.
