

2019 TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT REQUEST

AAA recognizes the resource challenges faced by law enforcement agencies as they attempt to provide their organizations with much-needed traffic safety equipment. AAA respects the efforts of these agencies and values their partnerships in our collaborative efforts to save lives and make our roadways safer. In response, AAA has established a grant application process that provides law enforcement organizations with an opportunity to submit requests for grant assistance to aid in the purchase of traffic safety equipment. This is an equipment-specific grant which means the grant money must be used for the purchase of the equipment outlined in the application. First consideration will be given to equipment used for response/ rescue efforts, education and enforcement. Examples of equipment that AAA will consider for this grant include, but are not limited to:

- Extrication equipment and/ or accessories
- Heavy lift bags
- Radar speed trailers or radar speed signs
- Roll-over simulators and/or accessories
- Traffic Incident Management equipment
- Presentation equipment such as projectors, screens, lamps, microphones, etc. (provided they are used for traffic safety based programs)
- Consideration will also be given to other equipment or enforcement items if they are traffic-safety related

The grant must go to a tax-exempt organization, and should be used in 2019.

Grant requests must be received no later than March 15 2019. Organizations will be notified of decision by March 29, 2019.
