

RESOLUTION

A Resolution authorizing the City of Crossville to restrict combination truck traffic along Main Street (US Highway 127/State Route 28), from Miller Avenue (State Route 392 South) to Genesis Road (State Route 298).

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to restrict combination truck traffic in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Crossville authorized a traffic study and the creation of plans for the restriction of combination traffic on Main Street and the designation of Miller Avenue as the "Truck Route".

WHEREAS, Tennessee's current law authorizes incorporated municipalities to restrict trucks on local streets and conventional state routes within their City limits; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation provides direction on how the restriction process is handled in its publication, TDOT Truck Route Restriction Guidelines 2019, and such process requires the passage of a resolution; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to create a safer environment for pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to expand economic development in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to increase residential development in the downtown area; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE THAT:

The City of Crossville is hereby authorized to restrict combination traffic along Main Street (US Highway 127/State Route 28), from Miller Avenue (State Route 392 South) to Genesis Road (State Route 298).
