

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to amend portions of Title 1 of the Crossville Municipal Code pertaining to ethics

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Title 1, Chapter 7, Section 10, Subsection (A) of the Crossville Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any resident of Crossville 18 years of age or older and a citizen of the United States may file a written complaint of ethics to the City Council for action. The Council will publicly review the complaint for merit and take such action as they deem appropriate within the parameters of their office.

SECTION II. That Title 1, Chapter 7, Section 10, Subsection (B) of the Crossville Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the City Council may direct the City Manager to hire a board certified ethics lawyer to investigate any complaint of ethics and a recommendation to course of action be presented before a public meeting.

SECTION III. That Title 1, Chapter 7, Section 10, Subsection (C) of the Crossville Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the City Council action to insure a public meeting and any appointment of an ethics lawyer be done within thirty (30) days of receipt of the complaint.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect upon and after its final date of passage, the public welfare requiring it.
