Current Status

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127 South Utility Relocation	(No Change) TDOT is looking to downsize this project so that the 26 A permit that is holding this project up, would not be applicable.
Safe Routes to Schools Grant	The City is awaiting the approval from TDOT for bidding. This approval is expected very soon. We do not know why we have not received the final approval.
Army Corp Study	GKY and the Army Corp will give a report at the October 22nd work session.
Northwest Connector Phase 3	The appraisals are almost finished and City staff has met with the company to start the acquisitions.
Northwest Connector Phase 2	(No Change)The preliminary Right of Way review has occurred and updates are being made to the plans.
Lantana Road Street Lights	The sidewalk has been repaired and the City is awaiting TDOT's approval before paying for the lighting system.
Cox Avenue	The contractor is taking their time finishing the project. TDOT will be charging the contractor a minimum of \$420 per day for each day the project is not complete. The project is currently in excess of 120 days late. Striping, guardrail and shoulder stone is all that remains.
Airport Runway Extension	(No Change)The Engineering Department is working with TDOT Aeronautics on developing a conceptual design and cost estimate.
Airport Box Hangar	The contractor is awaiting the delivery of the storm drainage structures. This has caused the construction time clock to be stopped and the contractor is not working. The building pad did not pass compaction due to rain and this will be rectified after the storm drainage has been installed.
Downtown Waterlines	The Contractor has installed the mainline from the north end to Water Tank Hill which is approximately 2400 feet of 12 inch waterline. The extension to the north is awaiting TDOT's approval.
Downtown Sidewalks	This project is in the design phase.
Brookhaven Subdivision and Highland Lane Waterline Upgrade	Plans are being finalized and the City is reviewing service replacement.
Holiday Drive, Lantana Estates and Fairyland Acres Waterline Replacement	(No Change) The plans have been approved by TDEC and the project is scheduled to be bid in December for a spring construction.
Old Lantana Road, County Seat and Southbend Waterline Replacement	Plans are being finalized and the City is reviewing service replacement.
