Call to Order

The Crossville City Council met for a special called meeting on Friday, January 16, 2026 at Crossville City Hall. Mayor Crawford was present and presiding. He called the meeting to order at 11:54 a.m.

1. Other Business

a. Discussion and action regarding financing options for Station #1 and #2

Finance Director Nathan Clouse discussed and presented financing options to Council including actions previously taken and additional options available.

A motion was made, seconded by Council Member James Mayberry, to move forward with using the Tennessee Bond Fund. The motion carried by the following vote:

b. Discussion and action regarding settling condemnation cases

City Attorney Randy York discussed settling condemnation cases for the Interstate Drive expansion since the road work has been completed. He recommended settling the two cases presented.

The first settlement is in the amount of \$12,100. The second settlement is in the amount of \$34,800. TDOT will reimburse the City for 85% of the settlement amount.

There are two additional condemnation cases for this project as well. City Attorney Randy York stated he could not present them at this time.
