





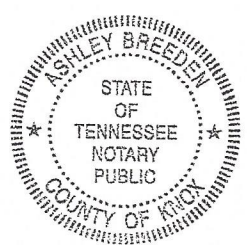

Sealed Bids will be received by the CITY OF CROSSVILLE at their offices in 392 NORTH MAIN STREET, until 2:00 P.M., and opened publicly at CITY OF CROSSVILLE- CITY HALL at that hour. The reading of the bids will begin at 2:00 P.M. (Local Time)

CITY OF CROSSVILLE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM (SRTS)

The work to be performed consists of the construction of sidewalks with accompanying curb and gutter and applicable drainage appurtenances in the Myrtle Avenue and Fourth Street area of Crossville, Tennessee. All work to be performed as shown on Plans and described in the Project Manual.
