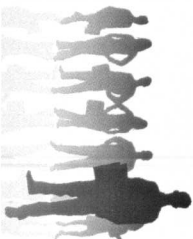

## Benefits

### For The Community

The costs of incarceration are reduced, and participants have the opportunity for gainful employment and/or continued education, enabling them to be productive contributing members of society. Juvenile participants are able to complete their education and get on a track that leads to a future of productivity and success.

The community safety and well-being are enhanced through a reduction of repeated drug use and related criminal activity.

### For The Individual

Participants benefit in many ways through the ability to lead a drug-free lifestyle. Assistance in employment and educational opportunities enhance their quality of life not only now but for the future. Upon completion of the program, the participant may receive a suspended jail sentence.

Quality of life and hope for the future are restored.

### For The Family

Anyone who has ever struggled with a family member with a substance abuse problem can appreciate the benefits to the family when their loved one becomes clean and sober again. Perhaps one mother of a Juvenile Drug Court graduate said it best: "This is a wonderful program. It gave me back my son."

Reunification of families is an important part of the Drug Court Programs.

## The Program

The Drug Court Programs target non-violent offenders with substance abuse problems. Utilizing a unique partnership between the criminal justice system and the drug treatment and mental health communities, participants receive an intensive and comprehensive array of treatment services for a minimum of 12 months followed by 6 months of after care. They submit to frequent random alcohol/drug screens, and receive on-going case management and support together with active judicial supervision and a system of rewards and punishment.

Drug Courts provide a continuing effort of collaboration between courts, treatment, and probation to reduce the use of alcohol and other drugs as well as related criminal activity.
