Sewer Mainline Extension - Ramey Road

The property owner at 141 Ramey Road (Tax Map 074 parcel 035.01) is requesting a mainline sewer extension to their property. The parcel is located outside the City Limits of Crossville. Under the Mainline Extension Ordinance and policy, 18-107, the total cost of the extension is the responsibility of the property owner. City staff is currently working on the cost estimate and that number should be available and be presented to the Planning Commission at the meeting. The letter requesting the extension is attached as well as a map showing the approximately location of city sewer and the parcel requesting the extension.

Under the ordinance, the Crossville Regional Planning Commission must review and make a recommendation to the City Council for final approval or denial of any mainline water or sewer extension.
