Request for Extension for The Grove Financial Guarantee

The Crossville Housing Authority is requesting a 12 month extension for the completion of Phase II of The Grove. We are currently holding \$10,000.00 as a financial guarantee for the completion of a cul-de-sac, in the event that Phase II is not completed. Due to the changes in construction costs, an additional \$3,000.00 is required to bring the financial guarantee to \$13,000.00. The CHA has provided a check to the City in the amount of \$3,000.00. The check has already been deposited. Planning Commission needs to accept the new agreement in the total amount of \$13,000.00 and extend the deadline 12 months to July 21, 2019.

Hedgecoth Division (resubmission)

At the May Planning Commission this plat was submitted and at the request of the representative, denied due to some concerns of septic run off from an adjacent property and a misunderstanding in regard to a strip of land not being 50 feet in width. The Planning Commission, in the motion to deny, waived the resubmission fee. The property owner is now resubmitting the plat for review. The southeastern property line has been adjusted to allow 50 feet of road frontage, as shown on the plat as L9. As before, the owner is requesting a variance for the requirement of an additional soils test, since city sewer is located to the front of the property. This property is located outside the City Limits; however, should the existing sewer system fail, the owner could then request outside city sewer or annexation.

City Manager Greg Wood asked why the property lines for the resubdivision were not parallel with the old property lines. Greg Barnwell, representing the property owners, explained that the old survey was for the original, probably 100-year-old, 50-acre property, and the new survey cleaned up some of the lines and tried to make the resubdivided parcel a true rectangle. Kevin Poore asked where the City limits were in relation to this property. It is adjacent to and across the road from the City limits so that annexation would be simple if requested at some point.

A motion was made by Mayor James Mayberry, seconded by Rob Harrison, to approve the plat and variance. The motion carried by the following vote:
