Lantana Road Utility Relocation	The contractor has completed 98% of the punch list. It has been discovered that the service feed to 3 street lights on the corner of Old Lantana and Miller Bypass has been removed and City Staff is working with TDOT to repair this service.
127 South Utility Relocation	Current bid date unknown. The right-of-way process is underway.
Safe Routes to Schools Grant	Waiting on direction on how to proceed.
Meadow Park Dam Renovations	The contract with Brayman Construction has been closed out and the Engineers are working on developing a budget for the bridges.
Turkey Oak Road Waterline Replacement	This project is complete.
Stanley Street and Gore Road Waterline Replacement	This project is complete
Chestnut Hill Landfill	(No Change) The Engineering Department is working with TDEC in order to reduce the financial responsibility that is required. TDEC had an onsite visit with us and they were very pleased with the maintenance of the land fill. We will continue to work on this item in the coming months.
Kingdom Hall Water and sewer Extension (Miller Avenue)	The City is awaiting payment for the materials before starting the project. All permits are approved.
Grindstaff Hangar	The topo survey is complete and a schedule will be developed in the coming weeks.
Tenth Street Drainage	(No Change) The agreement has been sign and the project is ready for construction.
Army Corp Study	The Engineering Department continues to gather data for the Engineering Firm and approve assumptions.
Dorton Way	This project is complete.
Satsuma Drive	(No change) Plans have been completed and the project will be bid with a time frame that will start construction in the spring of 2013.
Dog Park	The Engineering Department is currently working on specification and a bid package. The project should be advertised and bid in December.
Northwest Connector	Scheduled for TDOT's December bid letting.
Sewer Line Replacement Project	A contract and budget amendment will be on the City Council Agenda.
