

**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE CODE AMENDING SECTION 8-303 and SECTION 8-305

WHEREAS, The City Council desires to eliminate the two-year County resident requirement

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City of Crossville, Tennessee as follows:

That Title 8, Chapter 303 Section 2 (B)(e) be deleted in its entirety;

That Title 8, Chapter 303 Section 2 (B)(1)(f) be amended as follows:

(f) The names and addresses of at least 3 individuals who have known each applicant for at least two years, and who are not related to the applicant;

That Title 8, Chapter 303 Section 2 (E)(2) be deleted in its entirety;

That Title 8, Chapter 305 Section (A) be amended as follows:

(A) *Qualifications of applicant.* To be eligible to apply for or to receive a retail liquor license in the city, an application must satisfy all of the requirements of the state statues and of the state rules and regulations for a holder of a state liquor retailer's license.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
