

Dear Crossville Council Members

On behalf of the Cumberland County and Crossville Veterans Parade Committee we wish to petition you again this year for permission to hold a Veteran's Parade on Saturday November 5th at 10am along the same route as last year's parade. Map attached. Police support and road closures would be the same as last year, as marked on the map, likewise the placement of promotional banners on the streetlamp poles. Currently the Parade Committee is on track to have the same number of entries as last year, about 80 different groups. Unlike last year there will not be any speeches or a reviewing stand at the courthouse so the overall length of the parade should be about one hour.

Supporting and celebrating our veterans with this parade is a worthy endeavor that the Veterans look forward too. It's also important to display to our citizens that service is appreciated and valued. And at this time when so many of our recently discharged veterans are committing suicide, that they have not been forgotten is paramount. Last year, approximately 7000 spectators viewed the parade. For these reasons we look forward to having this request for the city's support of a Veteran's Parade approved and a parade permit granted.
