The intent of this letter is to provide you with information as to why Southern Police Canine Inc. is our soul source provider for our canine program since 2004. SPCI has provided our department with quality canines since 2004. The department purchased two single purpose canines that were very successful in taking dangerous drugs off of the streets of Crossville. Those canines worked the road over nine years until they both retired one in 2011 and the other in 2012.

In 2012 the department purchased three more canines from SPCI, two of which are still working as dual purpose canines. The canines that Mark Mills, owner of SPCI provide the department are second to none. I have been with the canine unit for over thirteen years and have seen many canines from other vendors and they just don't compare in quality or training we receive from SPCI.
