BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City will register the Notice of Limitation of Use against the Warranty Deed for the Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the project will be completed within two (2) years of the project contract start date

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Mayor James S. Mayberry, as the Chief Elected Official, is authorized and is hereby instructed, to sign all papers in connection with said resolution.
