In the identified area, the current year population is 11,125. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 10,795. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.71% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 11,538 representing a change of 0.73% annually from 2014 to 2019. Currently, the population is 47.9% male and 52.1% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 7.1% of the population in the identified area compared to 17.5% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 26.4 in the identified area, compared to 62.6 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$27,921 in the area, compared to \$52,076 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$31,047 in five years, compared to \$59,599 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$40,360 in this area, compared to \$72,809 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$45,132 in five years, compared to \$83,937 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$16,941 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$27,871. The per capita income is projected to be \$18,997 in five years, compared to \$32,168 for all U.S. households

Currently, 42.1% of the 5,469 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.7%, renter occupied; and 14.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 5,273 housing units in the area - 42.5% owner occupied, 43.6% renter occupied, and 14.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.64%. Median home value in the area is \$117,088, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.35% annually to \$138,069.
