

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Crossville supports the need for continued recreational activities within Crossville; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's Recreation Resources Division is accepting applications for the 2024 Public Parks and Recreation Grant Cycle.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Crossville will apply for 2024 Recreational Trails Program (RTP) funds for the purpose of making improvements within the existing park system; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City of Crossville will provide the required match of twenty percent of the total project cost as identified in the grant application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City of Crossville will accept financial responsibility of any cost overruns needed to complete the project as proposed and in compliance with grant requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City will register the Notice of Limitation of Use against the Warranty Deed for the Park if the proposed project is funded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the project will meet all Federal, State, and Local regulations including but not limited to the Americans with Disabilities Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the project will be completed within three (3) years of the project contract start date; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Mayor R.J. Crawford, as the Chief Elected Official, is authorized and is hereby instructed, to sign all papers in connection with said resolution.
