AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE CODE REPLACING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2 SPORTS COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the current Chapter establishes the Sports Council and it is of the desire of the City Council to replace the Sports Council and Lake Commission with one board.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to revise Chapter 2 Sports Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Crossville, Tennessee as follows:

That Title 2, Chapter 2, be as follows:

- 2-201 Creation of the Leisure Services Committee
- 2-202 Term on Committee
- 2-203 Operation
- 2-204 Duties and responsibilities

§ 2-201 CREATION AND PURPOSE OF LEISURE SERVICES COMMITTEE.

- (A) This hereby creates the Leisure Services Committee, which shall consist of nine members. The members shall be residents of Cumberland County. Members shall be recommended by the Committee and/or Staff and approved by Council. The committee shall have representation in the following areas:
 - (1) Palace
 - (2) Trails
 - (3) Marketing
 - (4) Parent figure
 - (5) Meadow Park Lake
 - (6) YMCA
 - (7) Youth leagues
 - (8) Member at large
 - (9) Leisure Services Director
- (B) The Palace Director and Meadow Park Lake Manager for the City of Crossville shall serve as exofficio members.
- (C) The purpose of the Leisure Services Committee shall be to facilitate recreational activities and special events, provide marketing for recreation within Crossville, promote sports tourism events and activities, promote good character and sportsmanship, and to advise and/or make recommendations to Council.

§ 2-202 TERM OF OFFICE.

Members shall serve three-year terms, except the first board which will have three members appointed for one year and three members appointed for two years, and three members appointed for three years. Members may serve successive terms, but not to exceed six years. Vacancies are filled

by appointment by the City Council until the end of the term.

§ 2-203 OPERATION.

Leisure Services Committee shall choose its own officers, establish rules and regulations, and keep a record of its proceedings to be filed in the City Clerk's Office. A City staff member will be available for administrative support. Copies of the minutes shall be made available to the governing body after each meeting by the Secretary. Meetings shall be held as needed when called by the Chair of the Committee. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for transaction of business.

§ 2-204 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

The duties of the Leisure Services Committee shall include activities that would directly impact the sales tax and hotel/motel tax, but not be limited to the following:

- (A) Recruit events and tournaments for venues in Crossville and Cumberland County and coordinate tournament incentives.
 - (B) Explore opportunities for new events and tournaments in Crossville.

This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2026, the public welfare requiring it.

- (C) Seek funding to support events and tournaments.
- (D) Act as a clearinghouse for events and tournaments for Crossville and Cumberland County to maximize utilization and prevent duplication of activities.
- (E) Facilitate marketing activities for events and tournaments in Crossville and Cumberland County.
 - (F) Recognize student athlete achievements.
 - (G) Develop tournament incentives.
