

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to amend portions of Title 4 of the Crossville Municipal Code pertaining to municipal personnel.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Title 4, Chapter 2, Section 3, Subsection B(3) of the Crossville Municipal Code, said subsection being entitled "Personnel Board", is hereby amended to read as follows:

No member of the Personnel Board shall be employed by or be an official of the city, nor shall be a member of any local, state or national committee of a political party or an official or member of a committee in any partisan political group or organization, nor shall hold or be a candidate for any elective office. No member of the Personnel Board shall be an immediate family member (wife, husband, son, son-in-law, daughter, daughter-in-law, mother, mother-in-law, father, father-in-law, brother, brother-in-law, sister, sister-in-law, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, step-parent, stepchild, grandmother, or grandfather) of any employee or elected official of the City of Crossville. The members of the Personnel Board shall be removable by the City Council only for cause, after being given a copy of charges and being given an opportunity to be heard publicly on the charges before the City Council.

SECTION II. All current members who may, or may not, be in violation of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby grandfathered by Council action through the completion of their current term of office.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect upon and after its final date of passage, the public welfare requiring it.
