| Mailbox Relocation | Additional boxes (new) since design, changed to individual posts instead of 2 & 3 mailboxes/post. Additional posts/mailboxes needed |
| Restore Asphalt Drives | Myrtle and Fourth-tie in driveways to new sidewalk. Grade changes created slopes that needed graded and new asphalt placed to restore drives to pre-construction conditions. There are 5 on Fourth Street and 11 on Myrtle Avenue. |
| Install Drain Pipe | Fourth Street – pipe provided by City to improve drainage issue experienced during construction with wet weather spring. |
| Concrete Testing | TDOT requirements resulted in the City being responsible for all concrete testing not the contractor therefore, DEPA started with this testing for the contractor and FECS is currently testing and will finish the length of the project. |
| Catch Basin | Poured in place - Fourth Street driveway was designed as a City Street for drainage but it is a wide residential drive resulting in the addition of a catch basin. |
| Cold Patch | City decided to NOT asphalt pave Fourth Street at this time so cold patch was placed between new curb/gutter and existing street to fill this void. |
| Yard Drain | 2 areas on Myrtle experience drain issues and new sidewalk slightly increased this drainage problem- 2 drains will be installed |
| Additional Gravel | This will be used to tie in existing gravel drives on Myrtle with new sidewalk bringing it up to grade. Additionally, gravel will be used between new curb & gutter and existing pavement on Myrtle to fill this void. |
