ITEM #8 – MATTERS RELATIVE TO HOLIDAY LAKE LEVELS

Mayor Pro-Tem Danny Wyatt led a discussion on the lake level to be maintained at Holiday Lake. He pointed out that most of his calls indicate they want the lake full except for one property owner. He pointed out that the minutes from October 22, 2009 were clear that the level would be left at the original elevation. No action was taken to make a change in the elevation.

ITEM #9 – MATTERS RELATIVE TO INTERCHANGE PARK

Mayor Pro-Tem Danny Wyatt reported that, in reading the purchase resolution, he discovered that the billboard property was excluded from the purchase. He admitted that he missed that when the resolution was approved, but will read resolutions more closely in the future. City Attorney Chadwell reported that the documents are being held in escrow while waiting on the official approval by the Comptroller's Office.

ITEM #10 – MATTERS RELATIVE TO AIRPORT T-HANGARS

A meeting was held with officials from the TDOT-Aeronautics office on concluding the t-hangar project and final funding of costs. Tim Begley reported that a final conclusion has not been received from the State.

ITEM #11 – MATTERS RELATIVE TO JAKE BRAKES

Complaints have been received for many years regarding the use of jake brakes by truck drivers moving through the City, specifically on Main Street and Lantana Road. A proposed ordinance regulating the use of jake brakes was presented for consideration.

A motion was made by Councilman Danny Wyatt, seconded by Mayor J. H. Graham, III, that the ordinance adding § 15-804 to the Crossville Code of Ordinances regulating exhaust braking systems/devices be passed on first reading. **Vote:** Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote (summary: Yes = 5). **Yes:** Councilman Boyd Wyatt, Sr., Councilman Earl Dean, Councilman George Marlow, Mayor J.
