### Ordinance amending Section 8-304 Restriction on Buildings and Location of Retail (Liquor) Stores

**SUMMARY:** Section 8-304 Restriction on Buildings and Location of Retail (Liquor) Stores provides, "All retail sales shall be confined to the premises of the licensees. No curb service is permitted nor shall there be permitted drive in windows."

As the current ordinance is written, the City of Crossville cannot issue a certificate of compliance for liquor stores if any of the provisions of the intoxicating liquor chapter is violated, including drive-in windows. State law does not prohibit drive in windows.
