Approval of temporary street closings for 5K "Race For Recovery" on September 24

### SUMMARY:

The Cumberland County Recovery Court is hosting a 5K road race to raise funds to bring awareness to September's National Recovery Month and to promote education on the disease of addiction epidemic.
