Discussion and action on FY2018 Transportation Alternatives Program

## SUMMARY:

Applications are now being solicited for FY2018 Transportation Alternatives Program (formerly known as the Transportation Enhancement Program) funding through TDOT. Mayor Pro-Tem Graham and City Manager Wood will lead a discussion on the potential of applying for funds for the sidewalks, street lights, and pedestrian signals for downtown. If approved, the grant will pay 80% of the costs. The deadline for applications is October 3, 2017.

This grant <u>does not</u> allow for the use of force account work (City employees doing the work). It will cover the sidewalks and pedestrian lighting. It will <u>not</u> cover pedestrian signals or traffic signals.
